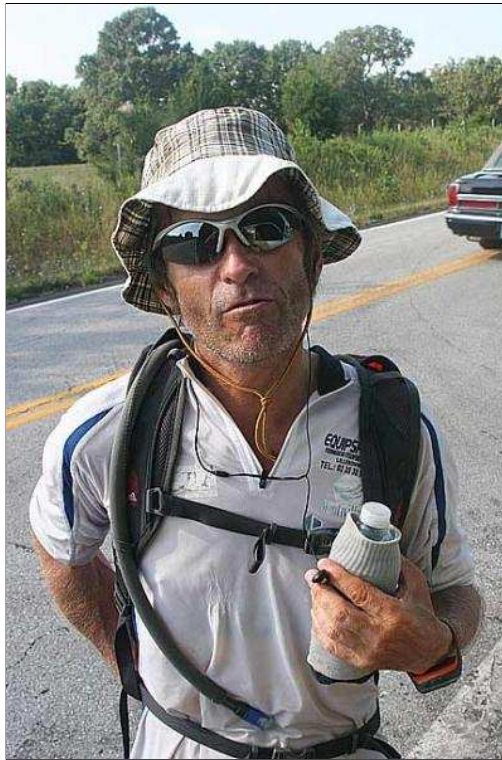
Runners -- men and women -- are expected to begin arriving in Hermann shortly after 10:00 a.m.

Fortunately, the runners are scheduled to stop in Hermann and rest until tomorrow. They will not try to run in today's forecast 102-103 degree heat. They will leave early [tomorrow morning](#); their destination for tomorrow is Bowling Green, Mo.

The LA-NY Footrace 2011 is a 3,200 mile, 70-stage race which started on June 19 and will end on Aug. 27. Runners are from across the globe, including Germany, England, France, Italy, the Netherlands, Japan, and one runner from the U.S.
